# Project European Dimension

The IJJO is participating and monitoring the European project European Dimensions in Juvenile Delinquency. The objective of this programme, financed by the Directorate-General for Justice, Freedom and Security of the European Commission, is to promote efficient indications to define programmes for the prevention of juvenile delinquency by taking into consideration the experiences and results that were obtained in five European countries. In each country and also on a global level, recent phenomena in juvenile delinguency. like cyber-crime and E-bullying, the influence of drug use on crime, youth gangs and finally the exploitation of minor immigrants in crime, will be analysed and studied. These topics were also developed during the International Congress on Recent 'Phenomena in Juvenile Delinquency: new penal forms' organised by the IJJO in 2007

The IJJO invites its users and collaborators who are interested, to contribute with their knowledge on these topics and to send us their suggestions, comments, researches, etc. regarding the development of efficient measures for the prevention of juvenile delinquency according to the four defined axes, by mail: oijj@oijj.org or on the IJJO Forum.


# COLLABORATION FORUM
