This meeting highlighted the importance of exchanging experience between educational organizations and the prison system, as well as promoting collaboration and the identifying specific needs for encouraging preparation for the release, and as a result, the reintegration of ex-offenders. This resource was developed with the goal of collecting together those terms which form part of the jargon most commonly used by professionals and actors involved in juvenile justice, thus being a practical and useful tool which aims to faciliate a greater comprehension and understanding of the concepts that define the different juvenile justice systems on an international level.
